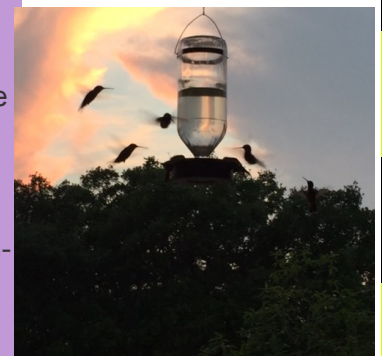

Healthy Sexuality Camp rising 8-9th graders

This camp will provide honest, accurate information about sexuality for rising 8th and 9th graders. The camp is based on the program values of Our Whole Lives (<https://www.uua.org/re/owl>); however, the camp cannot cover the full range of material in the 7-9 curriculum. We have selected key areas to address during the week: What is Sexuality, Sexuality Values and Language, Gender Identity and Expression, Sexual Orientation, Understanding Healthy Relationships and Relationship Skills, Consent, Intimacy and Lovemaking, Sexually Transmitted Infections, Teen Pregnancy, Contraception, and Sexual Decision Making. This camp models and teaches caring, compassion, respect, and justice. There will be workshops, activities, movies/videos and plenty of free time to enjoy the facilities at UBarU such as swimming, walking the labyrinth, and enjoying bonfires. Parent information meetings will be offered via zoom in May, June, and July. Parents will attend a parent orientation at the start of camp on Sunday, August 4, 2019. Parents are also invited to join campers for a closing celebration at 11am on Saturday, August 10, 2019.

At UBarU camp, we have solar panels on numerous buildings which can generate power for us and others on the grid. We have a Ham radio station to offer information to the community in the event of an emergency. We are connected with our neighbors!
