Reeb Camp Dean - YOUTH

JOB DESCRIPTION

updated Aug 1, 2018

- Purpose: To work in cooperation with the adult advisors, Executive Director and co-dean(s) to create meaningful spiritual and social Reeb camp experiences to further their spiritual, intellectual and leadership development of youth in the Southern Region in an inclusive, safe, covenantal and empowered environment.

THE JOB:

- Co-Deans are leaders and community builders who are in partnership with advisors, youth and Executive Director. Deans relish the gift they have been given.
- Deans will organize and lead camp programming.
- Deans will be available for planning between meetings to facilitate the planning process including to execute and supervise action items generated at planning meetings
- Deans will check-in with other leaders to make sure tasks are being done, offer support and encouragement to deans, advisors and others.
- Deans will be role models for younger youth demonstrating how UU principles are lived out during camp.
- Deans will facilitate a balance in the **Six Components of a Balanced Youth Program:** Worship, Youth and Adult Relations, Community Building, Social Action, Learning and Leadership during week of camp and the camp planning experiences.
- We encourage you to apply our UU principles to all **Youth Ministry** interactions.
- Youth Deans will follow all camp rules including no tobacco, alcohol, or drug use, no violence, and no sexual activity.
- Prepare for and actively participate in staff training and meetings.
- Set a good example for campers and others including cleanliness, punctuality, personal language, appearance, health habits, and sportspersonship, and phone usage (only during breaks or emergency)
- Encourage respect for personal property, camp equipment, and facilities.

Co-deans MUST:

- Be in Good Standing with their church, the cluster, and the district.
- Be an active member of their home church Youth Group.
- Be organized.
- Have a commitment to the youth and the movement.
- Demonstrate good communication and “people” skills.
- Have a willingness to grow their collaboration and leadership skills.

Commitment of time: Feb- end of Reeb week of camp

- Approximately 2-4 hours per month for planning meetings and preparation
- Attend UBarU Youth Camp- Reeb
- Debrief meeting after camp
